



MOCA 2.0® REGISTRATION

To register, log into your portal account and click on “Register for MOCA 2.0” in the MOCA section. The annual fee is \$210 for the first certification maintained and \$100 for each additional certificate.

MOCA 2.0® REQUIREMENTS

Annually	Register for MOCA 2.0 and pay \$210 every year to access MOCA Minute questions and submit CME and Quality Improvement activities. If you are also subspecialty certified, you will pay an additional \$100 fee per certificate.									
Medical License	Maintain unrestricted, unexpired medical license in U.S. or Canada. All licenses held must be unrestricted.									
CME	250 Category 1 CME credits with max of 60/year, including 20 credits of Category 1 Patient Safety CME Complete 125 credits by the end of Year 5 of your 10-year cycle to be considered "Participating in MOC"									
MOCA Minute	Answer 30 MOCA Minute questions per calendar quarter (120 per year by 11:59 p.m. EST on Dec. 31). You may review past questions and the question feedback in your MOCA Minute portal at any time. You may answer up to 30 questions per day and should answer 120 each year to be considered "Participating in MOC"									
Quality Improvement (QI)	Earn 25 points in Years 1-5 to be considered "Participating in MOC"					Earn 25 points in Years 6-10 (for a total of 50 points in a 10-year cycle) to complete the QI component

MOCA 2.0® PROGRESS REPORT

You may review your progress in the program at any time by logging into your portal account and clicking on "Review Your Progress" in the MOCA section.

At the top of this report, you will see your certifications, dates and statuses. You will also see “Participating in MOC.” You want your status to be “Yes” at all times. Participating in MOC requires that you register for MOCA 2.0 each year, and complete your MOCA Minute questions and any other requirements due in a particular year. Not participating in MOC will not change your certification status unless your certificate expires and you have not completed the program requirements. You will earn a new certificate when you complete the program.
